

Wailea Ekahi AOA COVID-19 Rules & Guidelines

We ask that you **PLEASE** follow the AOA rules and guidelines as they pertain to COVID-19 precautionary measures during your stay with us. The regulations contained in this document follow the CDC as well as our local State and County rules. It is important that you abide by the rules and guidelines below not only for your safety and well-being but for the safety of everyone at Ekahi.

MASKS MUST be worn while outside of your unit except when swimming.

MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCE at 6 feet apart and avoid physical contact.

GATHERINGS should not exceed 10 people, inside your unit or outside.

WASH HANDS FREQUENTLY when you can't wash your hands, use hand sanitizer.

IF YOU FEEL ILL OR HAVE A FEVER, remain in your unit. Refer to the CDC website for COVID-19 symptoms: <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/symptoms-testing/symptoms.html>

IF UNDER QUARANTINE you **MUST** remain in your unit until completed.

UPON ARRIVAL AT EKAHI – Please follow these steps (**DO NOT** come to the office if you are under quarantine!) *Either wait to get your parking pass or have someone pick it up for you.*

1. Please bring your parking stub to the office. If a parking pass has not been provided in your unit, you can pick one up at the office.
2. At the time you are issued a parking pass, you can turn in your signed **Waiver of Liability**. You can get that waiver in advance from your booking agent or by going to our website to the COVID-19 page: <https://waileaekahi.org/covid19info.php>
3. **If you have arrived after hours**; both our parking pass and waiver are provided next to the entry door as you enter the front office. Please put both your signed waiver and parking pass stub in the mail slot (black box) next to the office door. Our office hours are Monday – Friday 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM.

Upon entering the Pavilion/Pool facility please sign in and fill out all the necessary information before entry. There is a sign in sheet at the entry point of the Pavilion and the exit point from the Pavilion to the beach. *Please remember the Pavilion is **CLOSED** daily from noon to 2:00 PM for cleaning and sanitizing purposes.*

Please note we cannot accept or allow any reservations for use of our Pavilion at this time!

Use of Ekahi's amenities are permitted to those who are staying on property ONLY! Visitors "outside" of Ekahi are prohibited from using these amenities at this time.

- **Pickleball Court** – Is open but we will not be issuing out rental equipment from the office. You may use the court if you have your own equipment but please follow the social distancing requirement and hand sanitizing. Masks do not need to be worn during play.
- **Shuffle Boards** – Equipment is kept in the Pavilion/Pool facility. Check with our pool staff who can assist you.
- **Small Pools / Pavilion & Pool** – Please observe all rules posted. Please social distance, wash hands frequently or use hand sanitizer. Masks do not need to be worn while in pool. Limit all group gatherings to 10 and under. Wipe down lounge or chair after use.
